



# DONATION RESOURCE GUIDE

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What items are permitted for donation?

Clothing	Gently used or new tops, pants, dresses, skirts, professional clothing, jackets, accessories, shoes
Food	<b>Unopened</b> non-perishable, sealed snack items, boxed pasta, grains, canned goods
Personal Hygiene	<b>Unopened</b> deodorant, shampoo & conditioner, soap, menstrual products, dental hygiene products

Do you want my bedding? How about my rugs?

No, we cannot accept any bedding, linens, or pillows of any kind. We can't take your rugs or used shower curtains.

What about tea, coffee, and/or other beverages?

Yes, but make sure they are sealed. They are Cherry Pantry giveaways—not worth points. It's best if they're in their original packaging. Loose K-cups can get punctured and messy.

What qualifies as an opened package?

Anything that is sealed and has some identifying information is welcomed even if it's not a full box, like a package or popcorn or an individual packet of Easy Mac.

Can you take my furniture, like an office desk chair or closet organizer?

No, we can't take furniture of any kind.

You still want my shirts with stains or holes, right? Bras and undergarments? My offensive or incendiary t-shirts?

No torn or ripped clothing, profanity, and soiled or stained items. No bras or undergarments of any kind.

Remember, we sell these items during our Temple Thrift sales. Only donate what you yourself would buy.
